Guest Speakers



Daisy Godts

Daisy Godts is the senior principal orthoptist at Antwerp University Hospital, Department of Ophthalmology since 1993. She graduated in 1982 in Utrecht, the Netherlands in orthoptics and in 1984 in Leiden, the Netherlands in technical assistant in ophthalmology. She first worked in Lievensberg Hospital, The Netherlands (1982-1993) and still works as a free-lance orthoptist in 3 private eye hospitals in Antwerp and in Tenerife and La Palma, Spain.

She is a clinical teacher for orthoptic students of Belgium and the Netherlands (1985-today). She was professor in ocular motility in the Higher Institute for Paramedical Professions, Gent from 1988 to 1996. She teaches orthoptics and ocular motility to the residents in ophthalmology at Antwerp University Hospital (1993-today) and has been invited as guest lecturer in different countries (Israel, India, Congo, Nigeria, Rwanda and Morocco).

Daisy Godts' clinical practice focuses on the diagnosis and nonsurgical management of complex strabismus in both children and adults, in neuro-orthoptics, Thyroid eye disease, and amblyopia treatment in children with congenital cataract.

She has directed many courses at national meetings and has delivered numerous national and international presentations as an invited speaker.

She has published several articles in national and international journals.

She is active in several orthoptic associations; she was the president of the Belgian Orthoptic Association (2004-2010), she is representative for Belgium and the chairman of International cooperation program in the International Orthoptic Association (1990-today), she was the local organizer of the International Orthoptic Congress in Antwerp in 2008. She is treasurer and congress organizer of the Donders' Association of Strabismology (1995-today) and executive board member of the World Society of Paediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus (2016-today).

She has delivered eye care in charity organisations in Puerto Plata and Santiago, Dominican Republic (2009-2016) in Congo (2017-2019) in India (2013-2015) and in Rwanda (2022).
